PENGUINS ALUMNI ASSOCIATION 2007 SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee shall have:

1. Excelled academically with an overall minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.20 (based on a maximum of 4.0) or its equivalent. A student shall be nominated in the academic year in which he successfully completes the final season of eligibility. The student shall be evaluated based upon all academic work completed through the first term in which the final season of eligibility concludes.
2. Performed with distinction in terms of leadership, realizing potential, character and positive attitude as a member of the hockey team. The degree of the student's athletic achievement shall be weighed at least equally with the degree of academic performance.
3. Signified the intention to continue academic work beyond the high school or prep school level.
4. Conducted himself, both on and off the ice, in a manner that has brought credit to the student and his/her institution.
5. After satisfying the above requirements, consideration shall be given to participation in school activities, other than academic and athletic, in which the student has had the opportunity to demonstrate qualities of leadership and serve as an example to fellow students. Consideration will also be given to community and charitable endeavors.

NOMINATING INSTRUCTIONS

Six (6) items must be completed to be eligible:

1. The application to be completed and signed by the student nominee. Please type application or if necessary, print neatly and legibly.
2. The nomination and endorsement form to be completed and signed by the faculty athletic representative or the director of athletics.
3. An evaluation form to be completed and signed by the high school Head Hockey Coach.
4. An endorsement to be completed and signed by the applicant's academic advisor.
5. A transcript of the student's grades for grades 10-11-12.
6. Two (2) letters of recommendation (from a non-family member).
