## General Information

### Today's Game

The Rangers take on their division rivals, the New Jersey Devils, tonight at Madison Square Garden (7:00 p.m.) as they look to extend their home winning streak to three games. The Blueshirts have won three of the last four contests following Thursday's 2-0 win over the Capitals, and are now 3-1-0 through four games of their six-game homestand. New York, 5-6-1, is currently in fourth place in the Atlantic Division and ranks 10th in the Eastern Conference with 11 points. At home, the Rangers have posted a record of 5-2-0. The Devils enter tonight's contest having defeated the Maple Leafs, 3-2, last night at New Jersey. At 5-6-1, New Jersey currently ranks fifth in the Atlantic Division and 12th in the Eastern Conference with 11 points.

### Lifetime Series

Today's game will mark the second of eight meetings this season. In the season series, the Devils defeated the Rangers 2-0, on October 25 at MSG in the only meeting thus far. Overall, the Rangers have faced the Devils 187 times\* and have posted a 82-75-27-3 record, including a 46-26-20-1 mark at home. The Blueshirts have won six of the last nine meetings (6-2-1) at MSG, dating back to a 4-1 win, October 13, 2005.

## Inside The Numbers

Brendan Shanahan and Jaromir Jagr currently rank first and second, respectively, among active NHL players in all-time goals scored and continue to climb up many of the NHL's all-time scoring lists. On Nov. 19, 2006 vs. Tampa Bay, Jagr became the 16th player in NHL history to record 600 career goals and joined Brendan Shanahan to become the first teammates to reach the milestone in the same season. Shanahan accomplished the feat on Oct. 5, 2006 vs. Washington. ## **Outshooting the Opposition**

Through the season's first 12 games, the Rangers have outshot their opponents, 400-318, registering a positive margin in 10 of the last 11 games. New York has posted more shots than the opposition in 23 of 37 periods this season, including 17 of the last 22 periods, dating back to the October 13 game vs. Ottawa. Overall, the Blueshirts rank fourth in the NHL in shots for (400) and eighth in shots against (318) for a margin of plus-82 shots, which ranks second in the NHL.

## **NYR Recent Highlights**

### October

-On October 4, the Rangers kicked off their 81st season at home, defeating the Florida Panthers, 5-2, marking the second consecutive year the Blueshirts have won a season opener at MSG. Chris Drury, in his first game as a Ranger, notched the game-winning goal and added two assists to earn First Star honors. Jaromir Jagr tallied two assists, and is now tied for first all-time (Ray Bourque) for most career points in season openers with 30 points (nine goals and 21 assists).

-The Rangers defeated the Washington Capitals, 3-1, in the front end of back-to-back home games on October 12 at MSG. Scott Gomez tallied his first goal/point as a Ranger on his way to earning Second Star honors. **Nov. 2; Toronto 2 at New Jersey 3**

The Devils faced the Maple Leafs for the first time this season, while closing-out their first homestand (2-1-0) in Prudential Center history. The win gave the club consecutive victories for the first time since October 13-17. The team also improved to 2-0-0 in first games when playing on consecutive dates. Toronto out shot New Jersey 28-21 overall.

**David Clarkson's** first goal of the season gave the Devils a 1-0 lead, while **Mike Mottau** and **Martin Brodeur** each picked up their first assists of the new season. With the score tied 1-1 late in the third, **John Madden** extended his own franchise record with his 14th career shorthanded goal. **Zach Parise** (GW) also scored for New Jersey. Brodeur's victory (26 saves) was the 498th of his NHL career.

**Oct. 31; Tampa Bay 1 at New Jersey 6**

The Devils picked up their first-ever win at Prudential Center, evening-up their series with the Lightning at one game apiece. The victory also snapped the club's two-game pointless streak, and four-game winless streak (0-3-1). New Jersey out shot Tampa Bay 30-22 overall.

The Devils' six goals matched its highest offensive output of the season (Oct. 13 @ Atl.), led by **Jay Pandolfo** (3g-1a/GW) and **John Madden** (1g-3a). Pandolfo's hat trick was the first of his career, and the club's first of the season. He leads the team with six goals overall. **Dainius Zubrus** also recorded two assists/points for New Jersey.

**Arron Asham** and **Zach Parise** (PP) also scored for the Devils. Parise's goal gave him a team-leading 3g-8a-11pts overall. **Martin Brodeur** (21 saves) picked up his 497th career victory in his 900th career game played. He is one of just six netminders in history with 900-plus appearances. Defenseman **Olli Malmivaara** made his NHL debut.

**Oct. 27; Ottawa 4 at New Jersey 1**

The Devils returned home after nine straight road games to open Newark's Prudential Center. New Jersey faced Ottawa for the second time this season.

For the Devils, **Martin Brodeur** (23 saves + ENG) played in his 899th career NHL game. Trailing 1-0, **Brian Gionta** (PP) scored the club's first-ever goal at the team's new home. **Patrik Elias** and **Paul Martin** picked up the assists. New Jersey out shot Ottawa 32-27 overall.

**Oct. 25; New Jersey 0 at NY Rangers 2**

The Devils and Rangers played their first of eight meetings this season, and the first of four at Madison Square Garden. New York out shot New Jersey 31-22 overall.

For the Devils, defenseman **Sheldon Brookbank** and left wing **Jay Pandolfo** led the squad with four shots each. **Martin Brodeur** (29 saves) appeared in his 898th NHL contest. The game marked Brookbank's New Jersey debut.

**Oct. 20; New Jersey 3 at NY Islanders 4 (OT)**

The Devils traveled to Long Island for their first metropolitan area game of the season. The decision marked the club's first overtime contest of 2007-08. The winning goal was scored with just four seconds remaining in the extra session, marking the latest the team has ever allowed an overtime score. New York out shot New Jersey 36-28 overall.

Three different players scored for the Devils: **Zach Parise**, **Jay Pandolfo**, and **Brian Gionta**. **Dainius Zubrus** paced the team with two assists. **Rod Pelley** assisted on Pandolfo's goal for his first career NHL point. For New Jersey, **Kevin Weekes** (32 saves) took the loss in goal.

### New Jersey Devils Injuries/Transactions

For the Devils, defenseman **Karel Rachunek** (sore groin, suffered Oct. 27 vs. Ott., 2 gms missed) is out on a day-to-day basis. Defenseman **Colin White** (puck to the eye area, suffered Sept. 19, 5 pre-season & 12 reg.-seas. gms missed), right wing **Jamie Langenbrunner** (groin, 6 & 12 gms missed), and right wing **Cam Janssen** (separated shoulder, suffered Sept. 17 vs. Phi., 5 & 12 gms missed) remain sidelined. Total regular-season man-games lost to injury/illness: 38.

On Wednesday, New Jersey recalled defenseman **Olli Malmivaara** from Lowell (AHL).

## New Jersey Devils Notes

Last Saturday, the Devils opened their new home -- and the National Hockey League's newest facility -- Newark, New Jersey's Prudential Center. Prudential Center is the league's first new building to open since December 27, 2003 (Phx.), and the 23rd to open since October 8, 1993 (Ana.). The team was 15-5-4 in its previous 24 home-openers, all at the Meadowlands. New Jersey played in two previous arena-openers: Atlanta (Oct. 2, '99) and Carolina (Oct. 29, '99).

The Devils enter tonight's game following a 3-2 victory Friday evening vs. Toronto. Last night's decision gave the club consecutive victories for the first time since October 13-17, as well as a 2-1-0 mark during its first-ever homestand in Newark. New Jersey began the campaign with a franchise-record nine-game road trip October 4-25, going 3-5-1=7pts (.389). The franchise finished 511-341-105 in 957 regular-season games at the Meadowlands.

The Devils entered the new season after establishing a franchise record with their 49th win (48, '00-01 & '97-98) of the season in 2006-07 April 5 at Philadelphia. At 49-24-9=107pts (.652) overall, the club's win, point and points percentage were tops in the Atlantic Division, and second-highest in the Eastern Conference. The team recorded 40-plus wins for the tenth straight season, the longest current stretch in the NHL, and the third-longest ever (Mtl., 13, '70-83 & Bos., 12, '68-80). With a victory March 10 at Buffalo, New Jersey was assured of its 15th straight better-than-.500 season.

The Devils entered the Stanley Cup Playoffs for the tenth straight season, and the 16th time in the past 17 seasons. The club's stretch of consecutive post-season appearances is tied with Ottawa for the longest in the Eastern Conference, and the second-longest in the league (Detroit, 16). Overall, New Jersey was in the playoffs for the 17th time in its 25 seasons, and won the Stanley Cup in 1995, 2000 and 2003.

The Devils finished 25-10-6=56pts (.683) through 41 home games, and 24-14-3=51pts (.622) in 41 contests away from the Meadowlands. The team reached the ten-win mark at the Meadowlands in the fewest number of games in its history (tie, '87-88, 10-1-1 & '97-98, 10-2-0). New Jersey reached the 20-win mark at home in fewer than 30 games for the fifth time.

The club was 23-6-3 vs. the Atlantic Division, 47-18-7 vs. the East and finished 2-6-2 vs. the Western Conference. New Jersey's 23 victories vs. divisional opponents, 47 wins (tie w/Buf.), and 101 intra-conference points were tops in the Eastern Conference.

For the Devils, tonight's match closes its second of 17 sets of back-to-back games. The club is now 2-0-0 in first games, and 0-1-0 in second games when playing on consecutive dates. New Jersey will return to Prudential Center Monday night vs. Pittsburgh (7:00 PM, FOX Sports Net New York, Sports Radio 66 WFAN).

## Lifetime Series

Tonight's game between the Devils and Rangers marks the second of eight games between the two teams, and the second of four games to be played here at Madison Square Garden.

New York leads the season's series 1-0-0, following a 2-0 win October 25, outshooting New Jersey 31-22. **Sheldon Brookbank** and **Jay Pandolfo** had four shots each to lead the Devils, while Nigel Dawes scored two goals for the Rangers. **Martin Brodeur** was in goal for New Jersey, and is 0-1-0, with a .935 save percentage, and 2.04 goals-against average, while Henrik Lundqvist was in goal for New York (1-0-0, 1.000 save %, 1 ShO & 0.00 GAA).

The Devils lead the all-time series 69-59-23, but the Rangers are 34-24-18 in the previous 76 games played here. The remainder of the series is as follows: Nov. 14, Feb. 1, Mar. 19, Apr. 6 at NJ; Dec. 9, Mar. 27 at NYR.

### Brodeur plays in 900th game; approaches shutout/win marks

On Wednesday vs. Tampa Bay, Devils' goaltender **Martin Brodeur** played in his 900th NHL game, joining P. Roy (1,029), T. Sawchuk (971), E. Belfour (963), C. Joseph (913) and G. Hall (906) as the only netminders with 900 appearances. He enters tonight's game needing just two shutouts to tie 1920s/30s star George Hainsworth (94) for second place on the all-time shutouts list. Brodeur is also two wins shy of becoming the second goaltender in NHL history to reach 500, joining Patrick Roy (551).

### Brodeur starts opening night; ties NHL record

October 4 at Tampa Bay, Devils' goaltender **Martin Brodeur** made his 13th consecutive season-opening start, tying Tony Esposito's NHL record ('69-70 through '81-82) for most consecutive openers with the same team. Four other netminders started their team's opener in at least 13 consecutive seasons, though not for the same club: Terry Sawchuk (14, 1950-1963), Patrick Roy (14, 1989-2002), Clint Benedict (13, 1917-1929) and Ed Belfour (13, 1992-2005).

## Devils open Prudential Center

The Devils opened their new home -- Newark, New Jersey's Prudential Center -- Saturday night vs. Ottawa. The team's nine-game road trip to open the season matches the longest stretch to start a season in NHL history: Quebec in 1980-81, and Carolina in 1999-00. Both previous cases were due to building construction/renovations.

### Off-season happenings:

**May 18...**The NHL's New Jersey Devils re-branded its ECHL affiliate from the "Trenton Titans" to the "Trenton Devils." The team's new home and road jerseys will feature "TRENTON" in red across the chest, with a stylized horn in the "T" and "N," along with the familiar New Jersey Devils logo.

**June 13...**The Devils signed three players to contracts: defensemen **Andy Greene** and **Matthew Corrente**, as well as forward **Jari Viuhkola**.

**June 23...**Forward **Mike Hoeffel** of the U.S. Development Program was the first of six selections by New Jersey at the 2007 National Hockey League Entry Draft. He was drafted during the second round, the 57th overall selection. This year's event took place on Friday-Saturday, June 22-23 at Nationwide Arena in Columbus, OH.

**June 28...**Defenseman **Scott Stevens**, who spent 13 of his 22 National Hockey League seasons with the New Jersey Devils, and captained the team to three Stanley Cup Championships, was named one of four inductees from the player category to the Hockey Hall of Fame. The announcement was made by the Hall of Fame selection committee following their annual meeting. This year's induction celebration will take place Monday, November 12, 2007 in Toronto, Ont.

**July 3...**The Devils signed free agent forward **Dainius Zubrus** to a multi-year contract. New Jersey added to its defensive corps by signing unrestricted free agent **Karel Rachunek**.

**July 5...**The Devils signed goaltender **Kevin Weekes** to a new contract.

**July 10...**New Jersey signed defenseman **Vitaly Vishnevski** to a multi-year contract.

**July 11...**The NHL announced that the Atlantic Division Champion New Jersey Devils will open their new home - Prudential Center in Newark, New Jersey - on Saturday, October 27, when they host the Eastern Conference Champion Ottawa Senators at 7:00 PM in a rematch of last season's conference semifinals.

**July 13...**The Devils named **Brent Sutter** to the position of head coach. Sutter, 45, joins the Devils after spending the past eight seasons as owner, president, general manager, and coach of Red Deer (WHL).

**July 24...**New Jersey announced the re-signing of forwards **Cam Janssen** and **Grant Marshall** and defenseman **Olivier Magnan-Grenier**, while signing defensemen **Jean-Luc Grand-Pierre** and **Ian Moran**, and forward **Noah Clarke** to new contracts. The Devils announced the signing of three players to AHL contracts: forwards **Benoit Mondou** and **Joe Rooney**, and goaltender **Jason Smith**. The continuous monolithic pour of the ice floor surface took place at the team's new home, Prudential Center.

**July 25...**New Jersey completed its coaching staff, naming **Larry Robinson**, **John MacLean**, and **Tommy Albelin** as assistant coaches, and **Jacques Caron** as goaltending coach. They join recently-appointed Head Coach **Brent Sutter's** staff.

**August 1...**The Devils re-signed left wing **Zach Parise** to a new multi-year contract.

**August 7...**The Devils signed free agent right wing **Arron Asham** to a contract.

**August 10...**New Jersey announced the signings of three players to AHL contracts: forwards **Mark Pandolfo** and **Jason Paige**; as well as goaltender **Dave Caruso**.

**August 15...**USA Hockey announced that former Devils **Aaron Broten**, **Bob Carpenter** and **John Vanbiesbrouck** will be enshrined into the United States Hockey Hall of Fame.

**August 16...**New Jersey re-signed defenseman **Paul Martin** to a multi-year contract. The NHL's New Jersey Devils, parent company of the American Hockey League's Lowell Devils, exercised its option to extend the lease with the city of Lowell, MA for Paul E. Tsongas Arena. The announcement was made more than four months before the December 31, 2007 deadline.

### New faces

For the Devils, among the new faces on this season's roster are: goaltender **Kevin Weekes** (free agent); defensemen **Sheldon Brookbank** (waivers), **Karel Rachunek** (free agent) and **Vitaly Vishnevski** (free agent); and forwards **Arron Asham** (free agent) and **Dainius Zubrus** (free agent).

Defensemen **Mike Mottau** ('06 free agent) and **Olli Malmivaara** (free agent) made their New Jersey debuts, while right wing **Nicklas Bergfors** ('05 draft) made his NHL debut October 4. All three played in Lowell (AHL) last season.

### Openers

The Devils opened the 2007-08 season 16-4-4 in their previous 24 season-opening games, including 7-4-2 on the road. Until a 3-1 loss October 4 at Tampa Bay, the team was undefeated in its last four openers (3-0-1). New Jersey's nine-game undefeated streak (7-0-2) in season-opening games from 1989-1997 is tied for the fifth longest streak in NHL history.

## Sutter makes NHL coaching debut

On opening night at Tampa Bay, **Brent Sutter** made his regular-season debut behind the Devils' bench. He becomes the fourth member of his family to coach an NHL team.

**Brian Sutter** coached 1,028 games with St. Louis, Boston, Calgary, and Chicago, compiling a record of 451-437-140. **Darryl Sutter** coached 860 games with Chicago, San Jose, and Calgary, going 409-339-112, while **Duane Sutter** had a 72-game stint with Florida, going 22-42-8. While he is on the short end of NHL coaching experience, Brent was the top NHL point producer of the family during their NHL playing careers.

Where are the rest of them now? **Darryl** runs the Calgary Flames...**Duane** is director of player development for Florida...**Brian** coaches the Red Deer Rebels (WHL)...**Rich** is a pro scout for the Phoenix Coyotes...**Ron** is the Western pro scout for Calgary.

## Consecutive games played

Devils' left wing **Jay Pandolfo** is the team's ironman, entering tonight having appeared in a career-high 295 consecutive games, the third-longest such stretch in franchise history. Meanwhile, left wing **Sergei Brylin** is expected to play in his 259th straight contest tonight. **Ken Daneyko** holds New Jersey's record by playing in 388 straight games from Nov. 4, 1989-Mar. 29, 1994.

## Devils in overtime/shootouts

The Devils are 0-1 in overtime this season, following a 4-3 OT loss Oct. 20 at NYI. New Jersey goaltender **Kevin Weekes** signed as a free agent with the Rangers on August 26, 2004 and spent the last two seasons with the Rangers. He compiled a 18-20-5 record in 46 games with a 3.08 goals-against average. He signed with the Devils on July 5, 2007. D **Karel Rachunek** spent last season and the end of the 2003-04 season with New York. He was traded to the Rangers by Ottawa with Alexandre Giroux for Greg de Vries, March 9, 2004. In 78 total games, he scored seven goals and 23 assists for 30 points and added 42 penalty minutes. He also skated in six playoff contests last year, notching four assists. He signed as a free agent with the Devils on July 3, 2007. D **Mike Mottau** was the Rangers' 10th choice, 182nd overall in the 1997 Entry Draft. He skated in 19 games over two seasons, 2000-01 and 2001-02, tallying three assists and 13 PIM. He was traded to Calgary for the Flames' sixth-round choice (Ivan Dornic) in the 2003 Entry Draft and future considerations, January 22, 2003.

Devils' Assistant Coach **John MacLean** spent the 1998-99, 1999-00 and the beginning of the 2000-01 seasons with the Rangers. He appeared in 161 games overall amassing 46 goals and 51 assists for 97 points while accumulating 98 penalty minutes.

Rangers' C **Scott Gomez** was the Devils' second pick (first round), 27th overall in the 1998 Entry Draft. He played the last seven seasons in New Jersey scoring 116 goals and 334 assists for 450 points and 362 PIM in 548 games. Hartford Wolf\*Pack General Manager/Head Coach **Jim Schoenfeld** was the fourth coach in Devils' history, serving from January 26, 1988 through November 6, 1989 guiding the club to a 50-59-15 record in 124 games. He was behind the bench when the Devils' made their first ever Stanley Cup Playoff appearance and came within one game of the Stanley Cup Finals during the 1987-88 season.

**Notes:** Is now in his third season as Head Coach and eighth season with the Rangers. After being named the 33rd head coach in franchise history on July 6, 2004, Renney has led the Rangers to 40-or-more wins in consecutive seasons, a feat last accomplished by the club in 1974.

In 2006-07, Renney compiled a 42-30-10 record during the regular season and helped the Blueshirts reach the playoffs for the second time in as many years. He also guided the team to a first-round playoff sweep last season, marking New York's first since 1994. Season highlights include his 100th career victory (Nov. 21 vs. Carolina) and his first career playoff win (Apr. 12 at Atlanta).
